A **competition** for challenging and rewarding students.

A **benchmarking** test that shows teachers how much their students are progressing from year to year.



Highly motivational. Gives students the chance to win medals.

Educational. Helps teachers to discover and fix their students' knowledge gaps.



Gives teachers a platform for recognising talented students.

Gives teachers the progress data they need to improve their teaching.



One sitting window during July/August.

Three sitting windows throughout the year, plus a separate one for Writing.



Only schools can register.

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Five subjects: English, Maths, Science, Digital Tech and Writing.

Five subjects: Same as ICAS.



Schools receive results between two to four weeks after the tests, except for Writing which takes 6-8 weeks.

Schools get an updated results spreadsheet every day and online reports every two weeks.

ICAS and Reach *both* provide rich data on student performance, which schools can use to improve their education!
